Proposed Amendments to Revised Ordinances Chapter 20 Public Services, Article I, Section 20-9 Trash Removal and Disposal Service Fee:

First Amendment:

Insert the following proposed Amendment as number 1 and re-number remaining items as 2-10.

1. Conditions for participation in this service:

a) All participants shall recycle at curbside all items recyclable in the city (such as, but not limited to paper, cardboard, metal, plastic and glass)

b. All participants shall dispose of yard waste curbside during weekly City pick-up days (per Recycling Calendar) or at the city Compost Site at other times of year when the site is open.

c) All residential participants are limited to setting out for collection a maximum of two (2) 32-gallon trash receptacles (-not more than 40 pounds per receptacle) per dwelling unit each week.

d) All commercial participants currently serviced by the City is limited to setting out for collection a maximum of four (4) 32-gallon trash receptacles (-not more than 40 pounds per receptacle) week.

e) All participants shall limit construction debris to regulations imposed by the Department of Engineering in accordance with department of Ecological Protection (DEP) regulations.

Failure to comply with these conditions shall be considered as grounds for the City's paid trash collectors to leave unacceptable items curb-side.

c. All residential participants are limited to setting out for collection a maximum of two (2) 32-gallon trash receptacles (not more than 40 pounds per receptacle) per dwelling unit each week.
